In summer 2017 the reform of the Common European Asylum System (CEAS) with the aim of a drastic intensification of the European migration policy is about to happen.

Contents of the planned CEAS are:

- Limitation of the right to stay, leading to permanent insecurity for refugees
- Refugees have to apply for asylum in the state where they arrived first (first-country-principle)
- Abolition of „self-dealing“: States are no longer allowed to take responsibility for people voluntarily
- Saving fingerprints and face recognition (biometrical dates) up to 10 years, already from the age of 6 years
- Transmission of this dates to the persecuting state
- Restriction of the right to move by taking away all services, except emergency care, provided escape in another EU-country
- Stop of the asylum procedure in case of supposing “noncooperation”, even a person for example has lost their documents
- Possibility of arresting refugees while their asylum procedure
- Revocation of a granted permission to stay if the safety situation in the country of origin has changed
- Deportation of unaccompanied minor refugees
- Classification of the EU-neighboring countries as “safe”. Leading to urgent deportations if one of those countries where passed while the escape - so in every case actually

That means for refugees: Abolition of the right to move in the EU, reckless sentencing, monitoring and final powerlessness facing the asylum system. Deportation in a life-threatening situation. No perspective to stay long-term. No chance for a save life.

At the same time, the buffer zone around the EU is expanded further. Because of the bilateral contracts between the EU and African states the border will be moved beyond the territorial borders of the EU. The agreements include the finance and expansion of border police, arming and militarization by building high-tech-fences, Detention camps (already existing in Mali and Libya), as well as simple deportations declared as „development assistance“ and „fighting against the cause of escape“, pursuing to hinder refugees to reach the “borders of refuge” (alive). Those who reach the EU anyway are criminalized and marginalized. While the EU presents itself as an advocate for security and humanity, refugees are made into second- class people and generally disenfranchised.
